Cocopeat and coconut husk chips primarily are traded in bales of size 1'x1'x1/2' of weight 5Kg and 4Kg  $\pm$  0.5kg respectively. A single consumer such as a farm or ranch may easily consume 20 tons or more during their requirement period.

Another popular format for retail sales is the 20 cmx 10 cm x 10 cm briquette - 650g for cocopeat and 500g for coconut husk chips ± 50g. (Below left)



Cocopeat also comes in disks of different sizes and grow bags of different sizes. Popular formats of disks are 100g, 60g, 10g and 5g. Popular grow bag size is 100cm x 20cm x 5cm (Top right). Grow bags are often made with a mix of cocopeat and coconut husk chips in the ratio of 2:1.
